

AUSTRALIA PRIVACY ADDENDUM

Last Modified: June 15, 2026

SCOPE

This Addendum supplements the Newfold Digital Privacy Notice and applies to individuals in Australia. It addresses requirements under the Australian Privacy Act 1988 (Cth), the Australian Privacy Principles (APPs), and the Privacy and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2024.

The rights and processes described in the Privacy Notice apply to you. This Addendum provides additional disclosures required under Australian privacy law.

PERSONAL INFORMATION

Under the Privacy Act 1988, personal information means information or an opinion about an identified individual, or an individual who is reasonably identifiable, whether the information or opinion is true or not and whether it is recorded in a material form or not.

ANONYMITY AND PSEUDONYMITY

Where it is lawful and practicable, you have the option of not identifying yourself, or of using a pseudonym, when dealing with us. For example, you may browse our websites without providing your name. However, for some of our Services (such as registering a domain name or purchasing a product), we are required to collect your real identity to fulfill the service or comply with legal obligations.

CROSS-BORDER DISCLOSURE

Your personal information may be disclosed to recipients located outside Australia, including in the United States, where Newfold Digital's primary operations are based. Before disclosing personal information to an overseas recipient, we take reasonable steps to ensure that the recipient handles personal information in accordance with the Australian Privacy Principles, including through contractual arrangements and assessments of the recipient's privacy practices.

AUTOMATED DECISION-MAKING

Where we use automated processes to make decisions that could significantly affect your rights or interests, we will disclose the kinds of personal information used and the kinds of decisions made. If an automated decision significantly affects you, you may request a review of that decision by contacting us at privacy@newfold.com.

DATA BREACH NOTIFICATION

Under the Notifiable Data Breaches scheme, we are required to notify you and the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner (OAIC) if a data breach involving your personal information is likely to result in serious harm.

COMPLAINTS

If you believe we have breached the Australian Privacy Principles, you may lodge a complaint with us by contacting our Data Protection Officer at privacy@newfold.com. We will acknowledge your complaint within 5 business days and provide a written response within 30 days.
